Most interesting point (I think) was when we discuss mitigation of risk – being out of compliance with the fisheries act has the stick of large fines and jail terms, While we might be able to pay insurance companys enough money to cover the monetary risk you can not insurance against jail time (this came from a groups insurance company

Seems Province doesn't have a set standard for contracting with groups but there is a fish health and production process and all groups have gone through this process to continue their works for this year

Biggest task though was when we finally received the documents from our FOI request arrangements have been made to get our payment back due to lack of adherence to timelines) This was a hard 600 pages to review as it came on a disc but was a scan of a pdf – no search tools to help
